



Testing for coronavirus

How do you make an appointment for a test?



You can get tested if you have mild coronavirus-like symptoms

If you have cold-like symptoms, for example blocked/runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, cough, fever, or sudden loss of taste or smell, you can get tested for coronavirus.



Step 1: Make an appointment

To make an appointment to get tested at a location near you, call 0800 1202

Have your citizen service number (BSN) ready.

You can find your BSN on your passport, identity document, driving licence or payslip.

or

Make an appointment online using your DigiD via www.coronatest.nl

(choose 'English' at the bottom of the page).

When you make an appointment you will need to state your symptoms, your job, transport arrangements for getting to the test location, and your postcode.

You'll receive a text message and email confirming the appointment.

Stay at home until you go to the test location.



Step 2: Get tested

Come to the test location at the designated time.

Bring proof of identity and the message confirming your appointment.

Follow the instructions of staff.

A cotton swab will be used to collect mucus from your throat and nose.

The test is free of charge.



Step 3: The result

Go straight home after you've been tested. Do not leave your home until you have received the test result. You will be informed of your test result as soon as possible.

If your symptoms get worse...

Contact your doctor.

If you belong to an at-risk group or are very ill – for instance, if you have a fever or are short of breath – contact your doctor, specialist or the out-of-hours GP service (huisartsenpost).

In the event of a life-threatening situation, always call 112.
