

Call for the election of the members of the House of Representatives of the States General on Wednesday, 22 November 2023

VOTING PASS

When can you vote?

You can vote on Wednesday, 22 November 2023, from 07:30 a.m. to 09:00 p.m.

Where can you vote?

With this voting pass, you can vote at any polling station within the public entity.

Polling station near you

You can find this information on the website of your municipality or you can request it from your municipality.

Where can you find information about other polling stations?

You can find this information on the website of your municipality or you can request it from your municipality.

Contact details of the public entity

Here, you will find the contact details of the municipality.

Don't forget to bring when you go to vote:

- This voting pass.
 - Your passport, identity card or driving licence from the Netherlands.
- The term of validity of these documents may not have expired more than 5 years ago at the time of the election.

Strictly personal!

This voting pass is valid for the named recipient only. This pass is proof that you are allowed to vote and is valid only if your name and address are printed on it. Abuse of this personal voting pass is a punishable offence.

Loss of, or damage to, your voting pass

In the event of loss of, or damage to, the voting pass, request your public entity to send you a replacement voting pass. You may do so in writing until Friday, 17 November 2023, or at the desk until Tuesday, 21 November 2023, 12:00 noon.

To vote, you need an identity document

An identity document is a passport, identity card or driving licence from the Netherlands. The term of validity of these documents may not have expired more than 5 years ago at the time of the election. Under "valid until", the documents must state 23 November 2018 or a later date.

What if you do not have an identity document?

Apply for an identity document from your public entity in good time. If you are unable to do so, ask another voter to cast your vote for you. You can do so by granting a written proxy. You can apply for a written proxy from your public entity. Check with your public entity or go to your public entity's website. Make sure that your application is received by your public entity on or before Friday, 17 November 2023.

What if you want to have another voter cast your vote for you?

There are two ways to do so:

1. Either fill out the proxy certificate shown here and hand it - together with a copy of your identity document - to the voter who will cast your vote for you. **Important note!** This proxy can be granted only to a person who votes within the same public entity as you.

Or:

2. Apply for a written proxy from your public entity. Ask your public entity for information or go to your public entity's website. Make sure that your application is received by your public entity on or before Friday, 17 November 2023, at 05:00 p.m.

What if you want to cast your own vote elsewhere?

With a voter's pass, you can vote anywhere in the Netherlands. You can apply for a voter's pass from your public entity. You may do so in writing until Friday, 17 November 2023, or at the desk until Tuesday, 21 November 2023, 12:00 noon.

Important note! Do not give this voting pass with a copy of your identity document to any other person unless the proxy certificate below has been completed and signed by you and your proxy.

PROXY CERTIFICATE

Proxy signature

As a proxy, you must:

- cast the proxy vote together with your own vote;
- bring a copy of the identity document of the person for whom you are casting a vote.

Important note! In the election for the House of Representatives, you can vote on behalf of no more than two other voters.
