When can you vote?

You can vote between 7:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, 6 June 2024.

Where can you vote?

With this voter's pass, you can vote at any polling station within the Netherlands. You will find addresses of the polling stations on the website of the municipality or public entity (Bonaire, Sint Eustatius or Saba) where you want to vote.

What to do if you have lost your voter's pass, or it has become damaged?

A voter's pass can only be issued once. Have you lost your voter's pass or has it become damaged? Then you can't apply for a new one.

What to bring when you go to vote?

- This voter's pass.
- Your Dutch passport, your identity card issued by Bonaire, Sint Eustatius, Saba or the Netherlands, or your driving licence issued by Bonaire, Sint Eustatius or Saba. Check the 'date of expiry'. Does that say 7 June 2019? Or any later date? Then you can still use the identity document to vote.

This voter's pass is personal!

The voter's pass is personal to you. Only you can use the voter's pass: your name and address are on it. The voter's pass is valid only if your name and address are on it. Abuse of this personal voter's pass is a punishable offence.



To vote, you need an identity document

An identity document is a Dutch passport, an identity card issued by Bonaire, Sint Eustatius, Saba or the Netherlands, or a driving licence issued by Bonaire, Sint Eustatius or Saba. Check the 'date of expiry'. Does that say 7 June 2019? Or any later date? Then you can still use the identity document to vote.

What if you do not have an identity document?

Apply for an identity document from your public entity in good time.

What if you want to have another voter cast your vote for you?

Fill out the proxy certificate to the right. Make a copy of your identity document. Give the proxy certificate and the copy to the person who will cast your vote for you.

Important note! Do not give this voter's pass with a copy of your identity document to any other person unless the proxy certificate below has been completed and signed by you and your proxy.

Important note! As a proxy, you must:

- cast the proxy vote together with your own vote;
- bring a copy of the identity document of the person for whom you are casting a vote.

In the European Parliamentary elections, you can vote on behalf of no more than 2 other voters.
