### When can you vote?

You can vote between 7:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, 6 June 2024.

# Where can you vote?

You can vote at any polling station within the public entity. You may cast the proxy vote together with your own vote only. Check your voting pass for information on the addresses of the polling stations within the public entity.

# **PROXY CERTIFICATE**

# Call for the election of the Dutch members of the European Parliament on Thursday, 6 June 2024

## What to bring when you go to vote?

- Your own voting pass or voter's pass and this proxy certificate.
- Your Dutch passport, your identity card issued by Bonaire, Sint Eustatius, Saba or the Netherlands, or your driving licence issued by Bonaire, Sint Eustatius or Saba.

The term of validity of your identity document may not have expired more than 5 years ago at the time of the election. Check the 'date of expiry'. Does that say 7 June 2019? Or any later date? Then you can still use the identity document to vote.

# The written proxy certificate is personal!

This proxy certificate authorises you to cast a vote for another voter. This proxy certificate is valid only if your name and address are on it. Abuse of this personal proxy certificate is a punishable offence.



# What to do if you have lost your proxy certificate, or it has become damaged?

A voter's pass can only be issued once. Have you lost your voter's pass or has it become damaged? Then you can't apply for a new one.

In the European Parliamentary elections, you can vote on behalf of no more than 2 other voters.
