

Call for the election of the Dutch members of the European Parliament on Thursday, 6 June 2024

VOTING PASS

When can you vote?

You can vote between 7:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, 6 June 2024.

Where can you vote?

With this voting pass, you can vote in your public entity. You can vote at any polling station within the public entity.

What to bring when you go to vote?

- This voting pass.
- Your Dutch passport, your identity card issued by Bonaire, Sint Eustatius, Saba or the Netherlands, or your driving licence issued by Bonaire, Sint Eustatius or Saba. The term of validity of your identity document may not have expired more than 5 years ago at the time of the election. Check the 'date of expiry'. Does that say 7 June 2019? Or any later date? Then you can still use the identity document to vote.

The voting pass is personal!

The voting pass is personal to you. Only you can use the voting pass: your name and address are on it. The voting pass is valid only if your name and address are on it. Abuse of this personal voting pass is a punishable offence.

What to do if you have lost your voting pass, or it has become damaged?

Apply for a replacement voting pass from your public entity. You may do so in writing until Monday, 3 June 2024, or at the desk until Wednesday, 5 June 2024, 12:00 noon.

To vote, you need an identity document

An identity document is a Dutch passport, an identity card issued by Bonaire, Sint Eustatius, Saba or the Netherlands, or a driving licence issued by Bonaire, Sint Eustatius or Saba. The term of validity of your identity document may not have expired more than 5 years ago at the time of the election. Check the 'date of expiry'. Does that say 7 June 2019? Or any later date? Then you can still use the identity document to vote.

What if you do not have an identity document?

Apply for an identity document from your public entity in good time. If you are unable to do so, you can ask another voter to cast your vote for you. Apply for a written proxy certificate from your public entity. You can do so until Monday, 3 June 2024.

What if you want to have another voter cast your vote for you?

This can be done in either of two ways:

1. Fill out the proxy certificate to the right. Make a copy of your identity document. Give the proxy certificate and the copy to the person who will cast your vote for you.

Important note! You can only give the proxy certificate to someone who will be voting **within your own public entity**.

Or:

2. Apply for a written proxy from your public entity. You can do so until Monday, 3 June 2024.

Important note! You can also give the proxy certificate to someone who will be voting in **another public entity or municipality**.

Do you want to cast your vote in another public entity?

With a voter's pass, you can vote anywhere in the Netherlands. You can apply for a voter's pass from your public entity. You may do so in writing until Monday, 03 June 2024, or at the desk until Wednesday, 5 June 2024, 12:00 noon.

Important note! Do not give this voting pass with a copy of your identity document to any other person unless the proxy certificate below has been completed and signed by you and your proxy.

PROXY CERTIFICATE

This is my voting pass (my name is on the front). I do not cast my own vote and I authorise another person (the proxy) to cast my vote for me. To that end, I have given that person a copy of my identity document.

Important note! As a proxy, you must:

- cast the proxy vote together with your own vote;
- bring a copy of the identity document of the person for whom you are casting a vote;
- cast your vote in the public entity where the person who has authorised you lives.

In the European Parliamentary elections, you can vote on behalf of no more than 2 other voters.
